Colored Slow-Grow Broilers. A hearty, heritage-type broiler, grows slower than the Whites, but has much better foraging habits and abilities. Slightly smaller breast meat, more flavorful birds. Ready in 10 to 14 weeks.

**NEW I'll call them "'50s" Broilers**: Offered brand new this year from our hatchery, these birds are a cross between the two above, planning to capitalize the best traits of both. Larger and faster growing than the Colored, more flavorful and better foragers than the Whites.

Ready in 9 to 12 weeks.
